The Fall River County Weed and Pest Board meeting was call to order by President Jerry Wyatt at 1:07, June 16, 2011 at the Fall River County jury meeting room. Attending members were Jerry Wyatt, John Sides, , Loyd Thomsen, Heath Greenough, John Bogner, John Sides, and Nina Steinmetz. All motions unanimous unless otherwise stated. Motion to approve the minutes to the May meeting were approved.

Old Business: Bug Report: Dalmation Toadflax - Bugs survived winter and we received another 150 bugs to help with control in Hot Springs. The Common Mullein weevil is also doing well in many new places. Hope to pull bug in 2 weeks to deposit into the hills and hard to spray areas. ULV Grasshopper Sprayer is built and workshop will be in July – APHIS will be partnering with us to conduct workshop. Counts on grasshoppers are still low, cold weather is slowing the hatch. Hoary Cress Project - Spray time is pretty much over, will be contacting landowners to get maps done and receipts turned in. Would estimate over 100 acres has been sprayed on private land. Board members are asked to get their Automatic Deposit of Pay Form filled out. Mosquito flyers were given to Oelrichs, Buffalo Gap and Hot Springs.

New Business: It is to late for Air plane flying to spot Hoary Cress. Office will schedule for Common Mullein and Canada Thistle viewing the first part of July. The Weed and Pest crew has started ROW ditches - average 25 miles a day – weather permitting - using UTV -— mostly Canada Thistle so far. Heath G. motioned to have a Fall River County Fair Booth- 14 x15 - \$50 for 2011 and John Bogner seconded that motion.

Other Business: Loyd Thomson announced his resignation form the Weed and Pest Board. A heart felt thank you was given for his years of service to the board and to the citizens of Fall River County.
