The Fall River County Weed and Pest Board meeting was called to order by President Jerry Wyatt at 3:15 p.m. September 6, 2016 at the Fall River County Weed and Pest Office. Attending members were John Sides, Bob Novotny, Joe Falkenburg, and Nina Steinmetz. All motions unanimous unless otherwise stated. Motion to approve the agenda and minutes of the last meeting was made by , Joe Falkenburg and seconded by John Sides .

Old Business:

Mosquito surveillance trapping will be ending this week. Traps in Buffalo Gap, Oelrichs, Hot Springs, and Edgemont will be picked up and stored. The numbers of mosquitoes was very low this year and there were no positive pools in Fall River or Custer County.

The Fall River Weed and Pest Booth was quieter this year and had many nice compliments on the display.

New Business:

The Conservation and Forestry grants were turned in on September 1, 2016. The Board will need to amend the Common Mullein Assistance grant to increase the amount of funds for herbicide reimbursement to cover the receipts turned in. This can be done with a letter to the contracting agent.

Next meeting will be looking at a 2017 watch properties list like the one we had this spring.

Board members were informed of the Association of National Grasslands, Inc. annual meeting – September 19-20 in Crawford, NE. Supervisor will be attending to learn more about the Prairie Dog Occupied Habitat Methodology.

The next scheduled meeting is set for Tuesday, October 4, 2016 – 2:00 p.m. the Fall River County Weed and Pest Office. Meeting was adjourned.
