FALL RIVER COUNTY APPROVED MINUTES OF OCTOBER 16, 2018

The Fall River Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on October 16, 2018 in the courtroom on the second floor of the Courthouse. Present: Ann Abbott, Joe Allen, Joe Falkenburg, Paul Nabholz, Deb Russell and Sue Ganje, Auditor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was stated, and the meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m.

The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; none were noted. ALL MOTIONS RECORDED IN THESE MINUTES WERE PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Abbott, to approve the agenda as written.

Motion made by Nabholz, seconded by Allen, to table the county poor assistance as the applicants did not appear on time. With Nabholz voting yes, all others voting no, motion fails.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Nabholz, to consider approving the county poor application. Brief discussion was held and the motion was then retracted by Russell and Nabholz.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Russell, to deny CP 2018-6.

Motion made by Nabholz, seconded by Russell, to approve the minutes of October 2, 2018.

Motion made by Nabholz, seconded by Russell, to approve the notice advertising for bids for a 3-year land lease on 240 acres in SE1/4, Section 19, W1/2SW1/4, Section 20, all in Township 8 South of Range 3 East. Hearing for sealed bids will be on November 8, 2018 at 9:30 a.m., with the effective date of December 1, 2018.

Motion made by Abbott, seconded by Nabholz, to approve setting a hearing for 2019 Liquor and Wine License Renewals on November 20, 2018 at 9:30 a.m.

Donna Behrens, Coroner, met with the board. Behrens updated the board on a recent training she attended in Sioux Falls, noting that the training was good for law enforcement officials and coroners.

Lyle Jensen, Building Supervisor, met with the board. Motion made by Abbott, seconded by Russell to approve a quote from Duct Cleaning Service for duct cleaning in the jail and law enforcement offices in the amount of \$2,300.00.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Nabholz, to approve a quote from Audio Video Solutions for acoustic control at the south annex in the amount of \$4,351.00. With Nabholz and Allen voting no, all others voting yes, motion carries.

The board reviewed a quote for duct cleaning at the South Annex and agreed to wait to

do that.

Bob Evans, Sheriff, met with the board, noting that Deputy Steve Yenulonis has resigned. Motion made by Allen, seconded by Nabholz, to approve hiring Elizabeth Rakness to fill the vacancy as a certified Deputy Sheriff, at \$18.50 per hour, effective October 24, 2018, as per union contract.

Motion made by Abbott, seconded by Allen, to approve the copier lease for the jail in the amount of \$82.89 per month, 60 months, for a Kyocera TasKalfa 307ci color copier.

Evans advised the board on the number of inmates they had and the number of hours that have been spent in Edgemont the last few weeks.

Motion made by Nabholz, seconded by Allen, to table the Rockyford Road agenda item with Jim Ball until later in the meeting.

Suzanne Starr, State Court Administration, Director of Policy and Resources, met with the board. Starr updated the board on the importance of the Rural Recruitment Program for lawyers in small communities. The state judicial system provides 50% of the costs, while the county would provide 35% and the state bar would provide 15%. The county's dollar amount share would be \$4,479.00 per year for a total of 5 years. Revenues would be brought into the county in other forms by having the lawyer here. Discussion was held on the pros and cons of the program. Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen to have someone from an entity that is using the program to come speak to commissioners.

John McBride and Dustin Ross, Andersen Engineers, met with the board. It was noted there was no plat for Bennett Subdivision at this time. Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to approve the following resolution:

CONTRACT FOR HOUSING OF PRISONERS AND DETAINEES IN THE PENNINGTON COUNTY JAIL

Comes now, the Pennington County Sheriff (PCSO), located at 300 Kansas City Street in Rapid City, South Dakota, and the Fall River County Sheriff (FRCSO), located at 906 N. River Street in Hot Springs, South Dakota, and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, PCSO manages and operates the Pennington County Jail located at 307 Saint Joseph Street in Rapid City, South Dakota used for housing of prisoners and detainees and that FRCSO does not have adequate facilities in Fall River County (FRC) for the housing of prisoners and detainees, and

WHEREAS, PCSO is willing to enter an agreement with FRCSO for the housing of prisoners and detainees from FRC under the terms and conditions set forth herein.

ACCORDINGLY, the parties stipulate and agree as follow:

- 1. PCSO agrees to house and take care of prisoners and detainees of FRC, provide food, clothing, bedding, shoes, razor blades, and other items provided to Pennington County (PC) prisoners on a daily basis. Supervision will be provided by PCSO or its designee in accordance with the written document known as the PC Jail Policies and Procedures Manual. In return for said services being performed by PCSO, FRCSO agrees to pay PCSO \$80 per day for each inmate day. PCSO will bill for the day of arrival but not for the day of departure. Any fees collected by PCSO from FRC inmates for board, medical, or work release costs will be credited to FRCSO on their next month's prisoner board bill.
- 2. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that it is their responsibility to transport prisoners to the PC Jail at their expense and to provide transportation for prisoners to and from Court at the expense of FRCSO. FRCSO further agrees and understands that it is the responsibility of FRCSO to know when prisoners of FRC are to be in Court. FRCSO also agrees that PCSO will not routinely provide transportation for inmates to Court or medical facilities. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that if transportation is requested by FRCSO and agreed to by PCSO, PCSO will bill transportation costs to FRCSO at \$0.65 per mile and \$30.00 per hour for one deputy/guard and an additional \$20.00 per hour for any additional deputy/guard, as deemed necessary by PCSO.

- 3. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that PCSO will, when necessary, provide extraordinary and emergency medical or dental care for prisoners or detainees of FRC, that FRCSO will pay the entire expense associated with said extraordinary and emergency medical or dental care; including transportation to and from medical or dental facilities, hospital expenses, drug expenses, doctor expenses, guard fees and any other necessary and proper expenses born by PCSO in connection with extraordinary and emergency medical and dental care. FRCSO herein further agrees and understands that the determination as to whether or not medical or dental care is an emergency will be left to the discretion of the PCSO or his designee. If extraordinary care is indicated, the PCSO will consult with FRCSO to determine proper and reasonable medical care for which FRCSO will be financially responsible.
- 4. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that PCSO will bill FRCSO for prisoners and detainees held by PCSO for FRCSO. Said bill shall include the cost of each days housing or lodging at the rate of \$80 per day and any and all medical, dental or physician care incurred by PCSO. FRCSO agrees to reimburse PCSO on a monthly basis for all bills submitted by PCSO.
- 5. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that all prisoners and detainees of FRC housed in the PC Jail are subject to supervision provided by the PCSO or his designee in accordance with the written documentation known as the PC Jail Policies and Procedures Manual and any and all State standards that may be forth coming by the South Dakota legislature or other authorized committee or agency of the State of South Dakota.
- 6. FRCSO agrees to hold harmless and indemnify PC, PCSO and its officers, agents and employees, from and against any and all claims, actions, suits, damages, liability, judgments or other proceedings, including attorney fees and court costs, which may arise as a result of FRC prisoners and detainees being housed in the PC Jail and receiving medical or dental care and transportation services, all as contemplated and authorized in this Agreement. This section does not require FRCSO to hold harmless and indemnify PC, PCSO and its officers, agents and employees from claims or liability arising solely from the acts or omissions of PCSO, its officers, agents and employees.
- 7. The parties to this agreement herein fully agree and understand that PCSO may cancel this agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the FRCSO. Said notice shall be sent by certified or registered mail. FRCSO herein agrees and understands it shall have no claim or claims of any kind against PC or the PCSO for cancellation of this agreement. FRCSO further agrees and understands that should PCSO wish to alter any terms or conditions of this agreement, including the cost of housing prisoners, that said alterations or changes shall be provided in writing to the FRCSO by certified mail and FRCSO herein agrees and understands that said

- alterations or changes shall commence and take full force and effect thirty (30) days after notice of the same is received by FRCSO.
- 8. The parties to this agreement specifically agree and understand that any and all changes in this agreement shall be made in writing and attached to the master copy of this agreement which shall be held by PCSO. The parties to this agreement do further agree and understand that this agreement constitutes the complete understanding and agreement of the parties hereto and that no other oral agreements have been made that are binding upon the parties hereto.
- 9. FRCSO herein agrees to provide copies of the authority to PCSO to hold a prisoner or detainee. The authority to hold shall be either an Order of the Court, Warrant of Arrest and/or Complaint, Bench Warrant, Traffic Citation, Sentence, together with the signature of the officer delivering said prisoner or detainee on a form entitled Custody Authorization Form. PCSO reserves the right to reject any prisoner or detainee delivered without adequate authorization. Said paperwork is the consent of FRCSO for PCSO to bill FRCSO under the terms and conditions of this agreement or future addendum or modification of this contract.
- 10. FRCSO hereby acknowledges that PC is the owner of the PC Jail and that the operation and management of said Jail is vested in PCSO. Any rights, terms or condition provided for in the PC Jail as part of this agreement vests in, and is subject to, the ultimate control of PCSO.



Climate Considerations (preconditioning)

- Above average temperatures in September

Weather Considerations (triggers)

- Southerly winds
- Fronts or pressure trough
- Very dry conditions for 2+ weeks prior to ignition

Southwestern SD Overview: Large fires are relatively common across southwestern SD in November. These human-caused fires occur on days with a front within the vicinity, typically with southerly winds. RHs for most of the fires are well-above standard 'critical' thresholds. If long stretches (14+ days) of dry weather has been seen, the potential for large fires dramatically increases. Fuel curing can either be seasonal or influenced by drought conditions. Lightning causes only 1% of fire starts in November.

 - o Limited expectation for moisture in next two week
- Above average precipitation is expected

THIS INTEUTURE, mede this 20th day of August, 1936, between A. C. Petty, Sheriff of the County of Fell River in the State of South Dekote, party of the first part and the County of Fell River South Dekote, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

Whereas by a certain indenture of mortgage bearing date of June 20, 1926, Frank A. Buker and Mabel Ruker, his wife, of the County of Fall River in the State of South Dakota, and mortgaged to the State of South Dakota, the land and real property hereinefter described with all the appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging, which said mortgage was given as security for the payment of one certain promissory note of even date with said mortgage, executed by said mortgagers to said mortgage, for the sum of Eight Hundrad Pollars (\$800.00), and which mortgage was on the 21st day of June, 1926, recorded in the office of the Register of Daeds of Fall River County, South Dakota, in Book BB of Mortgages on Page 11.

And whereas said mortgage contained a power of sale that if the mortgagers made default in the payment of said principal sum of money or any part thereof or interest thereon at the time or times specified for payment thereof, then the whole, principal and interest of said note should become immediately due and payable and said mortgage might be foreclosed either by action or by advertisement.

And default having been made in the payment of the principal sum of money secured by said mortgage and the interest thereon, and the power of sale in said mortgage becoming thereby operative, and no suit or proceedings at law or otherwise having been had for the collection of the sums so secured, the said State of South Dakota did cause due and legal notice of foreclosure by sale of said mortgaged premises, to be given by publication of a Notice of Mortgage Poreclosure Sale once a week for four (4) successive weeks in the Edgement Tribune, a legal, weekly newspaper printed and published in Fall River County, South Dakota, where said mortgaged premises were situated, specifying in said notice the names of the mortgagors and mortgage, the date of said mortgage and the time and place when and where it was recorded, the mount claimed to be due under said mortgage, and a description of the mortgaged premises, as contained in said mortgage, and the time and place when and where the same would be sold.

And wheres, A. C. Petty, Sheriff of Fall River County, South Dakots, at the request of the Treasurer of Fall River County, South Dakots, on August 19th, 1935, at the hour of two o'clock P. M. at the front dow of the Court House in the City of Hot Springs, Fall River County, South Dakots, in accordance with said notice and pursuant to the Statute in such case made and provided, did expose and offer for sale at public auction said mortgaged premises, hereinarter described, and did then and there openly and publicly strike off and sell said premises and the whole thereof to the County of Fall River, a political subdivision of the State of South Dakots, for the angregate sum of One Thousand Sixty-two and 60/100ths Dollars (\$1062.60) said County being the highest and best bidder for said premises which constituted one distinct tract.

And whereas said officer making said sale did immediately thereafter execute and deliver to said purchaser the proper certificate of sale and did on the 19th day of August 1935 file in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Fall River County, South Dakote, a duplicate of such certificate, which was recorded on said day in said office in Book 5 of Foreclosures on Pages 132-3-4.

And whereas the evidence of said sale was duly perpetuated by the proper effidavit of publication of the notice of said sale and by a proper affidavit of the officer acting as suctioneer at said sale, which were recorded in the office of said Register of Deeds on said 19th day of August, 1935, in Books of Foreclosures on Pages 132-33-4.

And whereas the time for redemption of said premises has expired and no redemption from such sale having been made, and said party of the second part being the holder of such certificate of sale.

NOW THEREFORE, this indenture witnesseth, that the said A. C. Petty, as Sheriff, party of the first part hereto, in order to carry into effect the sale so made by him as aforesaid, in pursuance of the power of sale contained in said mortgage and in consideration of the premises and of said sum of money bidden as aforesaid having been first duly paid by the purchaser, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained, sold, eliened, remised and confirmed and by these presents does bargain, sell, convey, deliver, alien, remise, release and confirm unto the said party of the second part, the following described piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Fall River and State of South Dakota, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter (SEA) of Section Nineteen (19) and the West Helf of the Southwest Quarter (W2SWA) of Section Twenty (20) in Township Eight (8) South of Range Three (3) East of the Black Hills Meridian, together with all the appurtenances and improvements thereunto belonging or in anywise

epperteining, to the seid party of the second part, to have and to hold the same, all and singular, unto said party of the second part, and it's assigns forever.


FALL RIVER COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT SPECIFICATIONS FOR COUNTY ROADS AND APPROACHES



The above Typical Road Section and Typical Approach Detail (below) shall be followed in the construction of roads to be placed on the County Road System. Road design shall be consistent with published Standards of the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials. Road construction materials and methods shall conform to the current published edition the "Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges" of the South Dakota Department of Transportation, when referenced in the Standards below. Copy of these Specifications is on file at the County Highway Department Office.

The following are standards which shall be met:

- 1. Maximum Grade of any road or portion of road shall not exceed ten percent (10%)
- 2. Maximum Degree of Curvature shall not exceed twenty one degrees (21 degrees)
- 3. Crown rates shall be between 0.02 11/11 to 0.06 11/11. Maximum Super elevation rate in curves shall be 0.07 11/11.
- 4. Culverts shall be sized to assure proper drainage. The minimum size of culvert shall be eighteen inches (18") in diameter. Although fifteen inch (15") diameter will be allowed under certain conditions.
- 5. Gravel Surfacing shall meet the requirements of Part B of the Standard Specifications.
- Asphalt and Concrete construction methods and materials shall meet the requirements of Part C and Part D of the "Standard Specifications".
- All Dead-End Roads shall have Cul-De-Sacs with a minimum constructed radius of fifty feet (50').
- 8. Approaches shall be constructed perpendicular as practical to the County Road.
- 9. The Minimum dedicated Right-Of-Way width shall be sixty six feet (66').



TYPICAL APPROACH DETAIL

- 1. Only one approach shall be allowed to each tract or parcel of land.
- Existing roadway drainage will be maintained. Culverts shall be sized to assure proper drainage. The maximum size of

A contested case hearing was held before the South Dakota Board of Minerals and Environment ("Board") on October 18, 2018, in Pierre, South Dakota, on the above-captioned application of Peter K. Roosevelt ("Roosevelt").

Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Chairman of the Board appointed Gregg Greenfield to act as Hearing Chair. Assistant Attorney General Steven R. Blair appeared on behalf of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources ("Department"). Attorney Max Main appeared on behalf of Roosevelt. Petitioners Eckard Water Company, Quinto Ranch, LLC, Susan R. Henderson and Fall River County Board of Commissioners (collectively the "Petitioners") did not appear at the hearing.

Based upon the application, the recommendation of the Secretary of the Department, and the testimony, evidence and arguments presented at the hearing, the Board makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Roosevelt's application was filed with the Department on October 19, 2015.
- 2. Roosevelt's application and supporting documentation are complete in all respects and contain all required and requested information.
- 3. The Department caused due and proper Notice of Recommendation for a Permit to Inject to be given and published as required by law. The Notice recommended approval of the application, with conditions.
- 4. Petitioners all submitted documents that were accepted by the Department as petitions requesting a hearing on the application.
- 5. The hearing on the application was scheduled for October 18, 2018. Roosevelt gave proper and timely notice of the time, date and location of the hearing to all persons whose property may be affected by the hearing by mailing copies of the Notice of Contested Case Hearing, and copies of the Notice of Recommendation, by certified mail, return receipt requested, to such persons. An affidavit declaring that the Notice of Contested Case Hearing and the Notice of Recommendation were mailed, with the certified mail return receipts attached, was filed with the Department.
- 6. The Notice of Recommendation was published in the Fall River County Herald on April 12, 2018, and in the Hot Springs Star on April 11, 2018. Affidavits of publication were filed with the Department.
 - 7. Petitioners did not appear at the hearing.
 - 8. By not appearing at the hearing, Petitioners are in default.
- 9. By not appearing at the hearing, Petitioners waived and forfeited all due process rights they could have exercised at the hearing.

- 10. Roosevelt's application requests a permit to inject production water into the existing 2-33 Alkali Federal well located in the NW1/4NE1/4 of Section 33, T11S, R1E, B.H.M., Fall River County.
- 11. The 2-33 Alkali Federal well was completed with 268 feet of 8 5/8-inch steel surface casing, cemented to protect underground sources of drinking water, and 3,679 feet of 5 1/2-inch steel production casing, cemented to protect underground sources of drinking water. The injection zone will be in the Unconsolidated Sand of the Minnelusa Formation.
- 12. Injection water will be produced water from the 3-33R Alkali Federal well producing from the 2nd Leo Member of the Minnelusa Formation.
- 13. There are no active or plugged water wells in the one-half mile area of review, or the calculated radius of influence, around the 2-33 Alkali Federal well.
- 14. All plugged and abandoned oil and gas wells within the one-half mile area of review around the 2-33 Alkali Federal well are constructed such that injection into the 2-33 Alkali Federal well will not affect any underground sources of drinking water.
- 15. The Secretary of the Department recommends granting a 3,150 foot radius aquifer exemption in the Minnelusa Formation around the proposed injection well.
- 16. The proposed aquifer exemption does not currently serve as a source of drinking water.
- 17. The proposed aquifer exemption has a total dissolved solids content of more than 3,000 and less than 10,000 milligrams per liter, and is not expected to supply a public water supply system.
- 18. The proposed aquifer exemption cannot now, and will not in the future, serve as a source of drinking water because it is situated at a location which makes recovery of water for drinking water purposes economically or technologically impractical.

- 19. Using a conservative, analytical method, the Department calculated the radius of influence of the proposed injection to be 3,066.8 feet, which is less than the requested 3,150 foot radius aquifer exemption.
- 20. The proposed aquifer exemption is approximately 34.82 miles southwest of Hot Springs, South Dakota, where the Minnelusa recharge area is located.
- 21. The proposed aquifer exemption is approximately 18 miles southwest of Edgemont, South Dakota, the nearest city of significant population.
- 22. The proposed aquifer exemption is approximately 12 miles southwest of the nearest public water supply system.
- 23. The proposed aquifer exemption is approximately 2.8 miles north of the nearest identified water well.
- 24. The 2-33 Alkali Federal well is located on USDA Forest Service property, making the area unlikely to be developed for residential use.
- 25. The Madison Formation is the principal underground source of drinking water in the area of the proposed aquifer exemption, and is estimated to have 9,811,200 acre-feet of recoverable water in Fall River County.
- 26. The estimated cost of drilling a Madison water well is approximately \$92,840 more than drilling a Minnelusa water well in Fall River County, however, the superior water quality in the Madison makes it the preferred drinking water aquifer in the county.
- 27. If a drinking water well were drilled at the location of the proposed aquifer exemption, the cost to build a pipeline to transport the water to the nearest residential location would be \$839,520. The cost to build a pipeline to transport the water to the nearest public water supply would be \$3,352,800.

- 28. Based on the Fall River County population trends and the amount of available water in the Madison aquifer, there is a sufficient quantity of water available in the Madison aquifer to serve the current and future population of Fall River County without the development of the exempted portion of the Minnelusa Formation.
- 29. The proposed injection will not cause any degradation of fresh water resources or other mineral resources.
- 30. The Secretary of the Department recommends approval of the application, with the following conditions:
 - 1) Injection operations authorized under the permit to inject must be conducted in accordance with SDCL Chapter 45-9, ARSD 74:12 and any applicable orders or rules promulgated by the Board;
 - 2) Total number of barrels injected during the life of the permit may not exceed 8,212,500 barrels of water;
 - 3) The maximum injection rate must not exceed 750 barrels of water per day;
 - 4) The life of the permit may not exceed 30 years;
 - 5) The maximum pressure must not exceed 550 pounds per square inch surface pressure during injection operations;
 - 6) Prior to the commencement of injection, the Secretary's recommended Aquifer Exemption for this operation must be approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency;
 - A mechanical integrity test must be successfully conducted prior to the commencement of injection activity. The well must pass the mechanical integrity test at 1,000 pounds per square inch surface pressure. The operator is required to notify the Secretary a minimum of 72 hours prior to running a mechanical integrity test;

- 8) Once mechanical integrity is established, the well must be retested at least once every five years to ensure that mechanical integrity is maintained, unless the Department indicates differently;
- 9) If an unsuccessful pressure test occurs, the operator must cease operations immediately if it is determined the injection will threaten any underground source of drinking water. If the failure is not threatening ground water, the operator must cease operations within 48 hours after receipt of the Department Secretary's notice, and take corrective action on the well as soon as feasible. Corrective action options include repairing the well so that a successful test result can be obtained, plugging and abandoning the well, or any other action approved by the Department;
- 10) At all times, the injection well shall have an accurate, operating pressure gauge or pressure recording device and injection volume totalizer or volume recording device. The operator shall keep and maintain an accurate log of monitoring equipment readings which may be subject to review by the Department at any time.

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board hereby makes and enters the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties to and the subject matter of this proceeding.
 - 2. Roosevelt's application is complete.
- 3. All notices of the application and the hearing thereon, and all other notices required by law, were properly and timely given.
 - 4. By not appearing at the hearing, Petitioners are in default.
- 5. By not appearing at the hearing, Petitioners waived and forfeited all due process rights they could have exercised at the hearing.

6. ARSD 74:12:07:24 grants the Secretary authority to grant an aquifer exemption under the administrative approval process found in ARSD ch. 74:12:09. Because this matter was heard by the Board as a contested case hearing, the Board is required to grant state approval of the aquifer exemption.

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and good cause appearing therefor, it is hereby:

ORDERED, that Roosevelt's application be, and the same hereby is, granted, with the following conditions:

- 1) Injection operations authorized under the permit to inject must be conducted in accordance with SDCL Chapter 45-9, ARSD 74:12 and any applicable orders or rules promulgated by the Board;
- 2) Total number of barrels injected during the life of the permit may not exceed 8,212,500 barrels of water;
- 3) The maximum injection rate must not exceed 750 barrels of water per day;
- 4) The life of the permit may not exceed 30 years;
- 5) The maximum pressure must not exceed 550 pounds per square inch surface pressure during injection operations;
- 6) Prior to the commencement of injection, the Secretary's recommended Aquifer Exemption for this operation must be approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency;
- A mechanical integrity test must be successfully conducted prior to the commencement of injection activity. The well must pass the mechanical integrity test at 1,000 pounds per square inch surface pressure. The operator is required to notify the Secretary a minimum of 72 hours prior to running a mechanical integrity test;


- 8) Once mechanical integrity is established, the well must be retested at least once every five years to ensure that mechanical integrity is maintained, unless the Department indicates differently;
- operations immediately if it is determined the injection will threaten any underground source of drinking water. If the failure is not threatening ground water, the operator must cease operations within 48 hours after receipt of the Department Secretary's notice, and take corrective action on the well as soon as feasible. Corrective action options include repairing the well so that a successful test result can be obtained, plugging and abandoning the well, or any other action approved by the Department;
- 10) At all times, the injection well shall have an accurate, operating pressure gauge or pressure recording device and injection volume totalizer or volume recording device. The operator shall keep and maintain an accurate log of monitoring equipment readings which may be subject to review by the Department at any time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Secretary's proposed aquifer exemption be, and the same hereby is, approved and granted.







Generalized Stratigraphic Section Southwest Fall River County, SD














2-33 Well Bore Schematic
