The Fall River County Weed and Pest Board meeting was called to order by President Jerry Wyatt at 2:00 PM March 5, 2018 at the Fall River County South Annex meeting room. Attending members were Bob Novotny, Wayne Hageman and Nina Steinmetz. Also in attendance was Telca Paprocki, Buffalo Gap National Grasslands Representative. All motions unanimous unless otherwise stated. Motion to approve the agenda and minutes of the last meeting were made by Bob Novotny and seconded by Wayne Hageman

Old Business:

The State Weed and Pest Conference was held in Huron, SD February 19-22. Bob Novotny attended with Supervisor Nina Steinmetz. Bull, Mush, and Plumeless thistle was added to the Fall River County Locally Noxious list. The County received 3 of 4 grants requested, Horsehead Creek Noxious Weed Control, Leafy Spurge Challenge, and the Non-competitive.

The Private Applicators Training held February 28th at the South Annex was well attended.

New Business:

The Fall River commissioners approved wage increase for part-time sprayers and \$6,000 for a County Prairie Dog Rodenticide Reimbursement grant.

The Black Hills Botany Ecology Workshop will be held March 15, 2018 at the Game, Fish and Parks Outdoor Center in Rapid City.

Weed and Pest staff will be attending the Black Hills Invasive Plant Partnership meeting March 21 at the Game, Fish and Parks Outdoor Center in Rapid City.

The next meeting will be April 2, 2018 at 2:00 P.M. at the Fall River County Weed and Pest Office/ South Annex. Meeting was adjourned.
