Important Factors for Large Fire Growth in January for Southwestern SD

Climate Considerations (preconditioning)

- Above average temperatures in January

Weather Considerations (triggers)

- Above average temperatures
- Less than 0.20 inch precipitation in prior 30 days
- No wetting rains for 5+ weeks

Southwestern SD Overview: January wildfires typically occur after a long stretch of warm and dry weather that reduces the snow cover. Look for well above average temperatures and winds in excess of 15 mph. Minimum RHs do not need to be critically low for wildfires to grow large.

Southwestern SD January 2020 Outlook:

Fire Potential is Low*

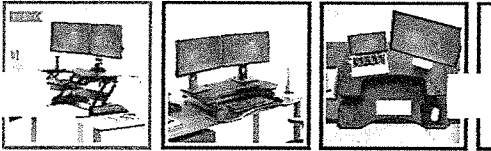
- Moderate snow cover is present over the prairie areas with some gaps in snow coverage in the foothill areas

DEAR MS. GANJE,

Thank you for your support of the Black Hills Regional Multiple Use Coalition, and our efforts to promote sustainable multiple use ethics in the Black Hills.

In 2019, the BHRMUC continued its commitment to addressing issues related to multiple use and management in the Black Hills. As always, the Coalition took its cues from members in outlining priority topics and agenda items for meetings. Some key issues from 2019 included: off-highway vehicle use and trail maintenance, wolf management, grazing on public lands, and forest management.

OHV use in the Black Hills continues to be a priority issue for the BHRMUC and its members. We began tackling the issue of irresponsible OHV use a couple years ago through an advertising and social media campaign titled “Ride with Respect Black Hills”, and funded through a grant from the State of SD. We have taken what we learned through that endeavor and are applying that knowledge in current and future efforts as we continue working with our member OHV organizations, local businesses, and land management agencies. Ultimately, the Coalition is advocating for robust OHV trail use that also coincides with sustaining our natural resources.

Wolf management has remained a topic of interest to some of our member organizations. Spurred by national news and events, this topic became a priority for the BHRMUC in 2019. Through member discussions, a venue to explore this issue with public involvement was desired. To that end, the BHRMUC sponsored and organized a “Wolf Symposium” in Spearfish with speakers from the Lander, WY USFWS office, SDGFP, and an author and previous AAW VERITAS Award winner from Minnesota. There was excellent turnout with healthy discussion.

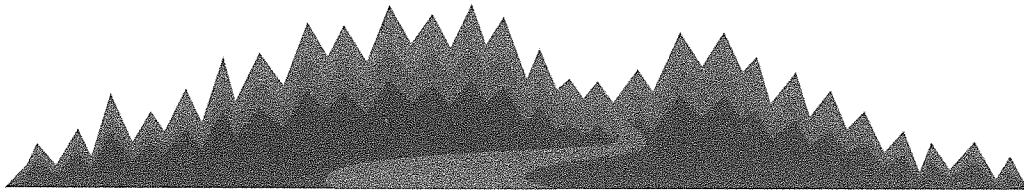
The BHRMUC also continued ongoing discussions with the Black Hills National Forest and Nebraska National Forest regarding grazing and forest management – two issues central to some Coalition members. There are numerous intricacies involved with both these topics making it difficult to detail here. However, discussions have been mostly positive with FS officials and we believe the Coalition is helping send the message of the importance of these activities in the Black Hills region.

Your personal and financial commitments to our campaign for multiple use management in and around the Black Hills are crucial. We hope you will continue your support in 2020.
