Dear Senator Rounds,

As the national conversation on infrastructure concludes in the coming weeks, several provisions have been brought to our attention that we believe would impact the supply chain in Fall River County. Several sections within the House's version of the infrastructure bill would disrupt freight rail operations and service across South Dakota, push heavier trucks onto local highways, and negatively impact such aspects as our oil and gas development and international trade.

These include such provisions as requiring crew size mandates on railroads but not on other modes of transportation and a multi-billion dollar unfunded mandate to replace locomotives built prior to 2008. Another provision would require freight trains coming into the United States from Mexico to nearly immediately stop once they enter the country and perform a Mexicanto-American crew interchange and safety inspections. This contradicts an existing procedure allowing trains to proceed up to 15 miles inland and stop at proper railyards before they make their exchanges and checks thus risking unsafe conditions on the border and bottlenecks with international trade. These are just some of the provisions that are causes for concern in the rail title of the bill that could adversely impact rail service in South Dakota and nationwide.


Closer to home, a provision in the House bill would effectively prohibit the movement of fossil fuels, namely liquefied natural gas, by freight trains. Moving these products by rail is one of the key methods of moving these materials from nearby developments like the Bakken Field. Interestingly this prohibition does not extend to other forms of transportation such as the trucking industry. This means we may see an increase in heavy trucks carrying these materials in places like Fall River County as they move southward towards distribution hubs like Denver. Policies like these aren't just shortsighted because they needlessly attack an industry but they

create ancillary problems for our communities. Moving freight by rail is three times more efficient than trucks and 99.99 percent of hazmat trains reach their final destination without incident. Policy changes that push more freight onto trucks actually increase pollution all while making roads less safe for passenger vehicles. In addition, the freight rail industry is privately owned, operated and maintained which means they cover the cost of their own infrastructure and repair. Pushing more trucks onto local highways only increases the burden on South Dakota taxpayers.

As a result of these issues, the county is requesting you oppose unnecessary policies like these whether they be included in a final infrastructure bill in the coming weeks or in future efforts that would impact the freight rail system. Instead, I would urge you to consider the existing benefits our freight rail system provides our economy and local communities such as efficiently moving freight, helping to lower emissions, creating good paying jobs, and providing transportation options to local businesses when weighing your infrastructure policies.

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

- 1. <u>SD Dept. of Emergency Management:</u> I attended the Edgemont City Council Meeting on September 7<sup>th</sup>, to provide updates to the county Pre Disaster Mitigation Plan (PDM) and the Local Emergency Operations Plan (LEOP). I attended the Oelrichs Town Board meeting on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 to provide the same information. I am scheduled to attend the Hot Springs City Council meeting on September 20, 2021 to do the required updates.
- 2. <u>Fall River County Annual Exercise</u>: The exercise was held on Sept. 15, 2021. I will be completing the required paperwork tor full credit.
- 3. <u>Corrections Training (Lexipol):</u> One of the requirements for the Safety Benefits program is to provide training to jailers, dispatchers, and law enforcement personnel. Lexipol provides virtual training modules to accomplish these requirements. Additionally, there are modules that meet the needs of the office personnel within the county. The cost is \$3,264 per year for 51 employees. I would recommend approval.

**PIERRE, S.D.** – Today, the Legislature's Interim Rules Review Committee approved the Department of Health's proposed administrative rules to establish a medical cannabis program in South Dakota. The legislature approved 143 of 149 proposed rules.

Following the legislature's endorsement of the rules, Governor Kristi Noem and Secretary of Health Kim Malsam-Rysdon released the following statements:

"We are on track to implement a responsible medical cannabis program in South Dakota according to the direction given by the voters," said **Governor Noem**. "I commend the Department of Health for its hard work to streamline the process. South Dakota will continue to implement the best, most patient-focused medical cannabis program in the country."

"The passage of today's proposed rules package by the committee is the result of months of work. It's proof that the public engagement process works," said Kim Malsam-Rysdon, Secretary of Health. "I am disappointed the rules review committee chose to take out the list of specific medical conditions for qualifying medical cannabis patients, a list the Department promulgated based on public input."
