ORDER FOR ORGANIZATION AND INCORPORATION OF THE ANGOSTURA LAND ESTATES ROAD DISTRICT FALL RIVER COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA

WHEREAS, all voting property owners that are within the proposed district have agreed to and petitioned for the organization of the Angostura Land Estates Road District, and

WHEREAS, an Election was held on July 12, 2022 asking the voters to accept or reject the formation of the Angostura Land Estates Road District, with _8_ voters accepting and _4_ voters rejecting the formation of the Angostura Land Estates Road District, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that the Fall River County Commissioners shall declare the Angostura Land Estates Road District to be organized and established as a governmental subdivision of the State of South Dakota and a public body, corporate and political, effective as of today's date, with taxing authority for the 2022 tax year payable in 2023 and after, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Angostura Land Estates Road District be described as follows:

Angostura Land Estates consisting of Lot One A (1A), One B (1B), One C (1C), Lot One (1) through Forty-Four (44) and Well Lot on Block One (1), Tract A, Tract B, and Road Tract, Lots One (1) One through Thirty-Four (34) of Block Two (2), Lots One (1) through Twenty-Four (24) of Block Three (3), located in the West Half (W 1/2) of Section Twenty-Nine (29) and the East Half (E 1/2) of Section Thirty (30), in Township Eight South (T8S), Range Six East (R6E) of the Black Hills Meridian, Fall River County, South Dakota, specifically including any area or parcel designated as a utility easement on the recorded plat of Angostura Land Estates, but specifically excluding the parcel or area encompassed or lying within the forty foot (40') wide private access and utility easement surrounded by Block 1, 2, and 3.

FALL RIVER COUNTY ORDINANCE #2022 – 01 REGULATION FOR THE PLACEMENT OF NOVELTY ROAD SIGNS

ARTICLE 1 - PURPOSE AND INTENT

The Board of County Commissioners of Fall River County enacts the following ordinance to prevent confusion between novelty road name signs and road name signs belonging to the official 911 road system, as such confusion may lead to a loss of life and property.

ARTICLE 2 – DEFINITION

Official 911 road names – Road names that are used by the county for the 911 addressing system. These road names have been official recognized by the county and the State for addressing purposes.

Novelty Road Sign – A sign with a road name that is not part of the official 911 road name system or a sign with an official road name that is not located along the correct road.

ARTICLE 3 - RULES

No novelty road sign may be installed is such a way that it may be confused with an official 911 road sign. This includes but it not limited to:

- Installing a novelty road sign on a metal post at a road intersection
- Installing a novelty road sign on a metal post at the intersection of a road and driveway

Novelty road signs can be installed in the following manner:

- On buildings
- On fences
- On metal posts not located at a road intersection, such as a post in a garden

ARTICLE 3 - REMOVAL OF SIGN

If a sign is found in violation of this ordinance a letter will be sent to the owner of said sign asking for it's removal or a change in installation. If the installation of the sign is not changed to meet the requirements of this ordinance within a month the county will confiscate the road sign.

Signs that are determined to be an immediate danger to the 911 system will be confiscated immediately and then the owner informed. An example of this would be a road name sign with an official 911 road name being installed along the wrong road.





Highway Superintendent Seiler, Chairman Falkenburg, and County Commissioners,

In response to the recent request for financial assistance on road improvements being performed on Fall River County Road 71A or "Sheps Canyon Road", the department has come up with the following recommendations:

Regarding improvements in 2022, the department would like to offer 50% of the magnesium chloride application cost of \$17,500 (\$35,000/2). Due to lack of scheduled budgeted funding for improvements on this portion of road, the department is only able to accommodate a much smaller financial commitment than requested. As a reminder, for scheduled funding in our state budget we would like to see a full scope of work, requested amount of funding/cost-share prior to July 1st for the following construction season. During Mr. Seiler and I's phone conversation on Wednesday July 6th, it appears the financial constraints of both entities may prohibit a hard surface on this section of road for the forceable future and anticipating annual mag water treatments like we had done prior to the 2021 is more likely. The department will budget for a 50% cost share on a single magnesium chloride treatment in our FY24 budget for the 2023 season unless the county has interest in requesting for additional financial assistance on road improvements in 2023.

To provide support for the future of the road, I would like to bring your attention to a program administered through the federal government known as FLAP. FLAP- Federal Lands Access Program administered through FHWA (Federal Highway Administration). This program allocates federal funding for road improvement projects that link local jurisdiction roads to federal lands. County and state governments are able to apply for these through a competitive grant process with a desirable cost-share of federal funds (approximately 80/20). https://highways.dot.gov/federal-lands/programs-access The next anticipated round of a "call for projects" is scheduled for 2025. Another source the county may be eligible for is through the FLTP program (Federal Lands Transportation Program). https://highways.dot.gov/federal-lands/programs/transportation This program is also administered through the FHWA. It is my understanding they will be waiting until 2024 before they will open another cycle of applications to be submitted, scored, and allocation of funds given out based on the scoring results.

Thank you for your continued support on quality road improvement projects throughout the county.



RESOLUTION NO. 3

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BLACK HILLS FOREST SERVICE RESPOND TO BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST COUNTIES' CALL FOR A SECOND DRAFT OF ASSESSMENTS

WHEREAS, the Counties of Crook, Custer, Fall River, Lawrence, Meade, Pennington, and Weston have determined it necessary to address deficiencies in the Forest Service Draft Assessments for the Forest Plan Revision; and

WHEREAS, the Counties of the Black Hills National Forest have reviewed the draft assessments, and have determined that the 2012 Forest Planning Rule, has not been followed; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Planning Rule requires the Forest Service to "document and summarize how the universe of best available scientific information" has been utilized however best available scientific information has not been included in the draft assessments; and

WHEREAS, the Counties of the Black Hills National Forest have determined that the assessments have multiple data gaps and therefore cannot properly inform the Forest Service on their planning process or properly inform development of the Plan Revision; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service is rushing the process to meet a pre-determined schedule rather than encouraging a process that properly engages stakeholders or properly assesses the current resources of the Black Hills National Forest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- The Counties of Counties of Crook, Custer, Fall River, Lawrence, Meade, Pennington, and Weston are calling for a second draft of the assessments be completed by the Forest Service which address data gaps, utilize best available scientific information, refrain from including obsolete data, and omit or acknowledge conflicting statements between assessments, refrain from bias and/or unsupported statements.
- 2. The Counties of Counties of Crook, Custer, Fall River, Lawrence, Meade, Pennington, and Weston are requesting that the Forest Service properly engage all stakeholders and local governments.
- 3. The Counties of Counties of Crook, Custer, Fall River, Lawrence, Meade, Pennington, and Weston are calling on the Forest Service to expedite the process of approving the Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperating Agency Status.

AGREEMENT OF FEES FOR COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

- 7. Client agrees to defend, indemnify and hold CCB harmless from and against any damages, suits, or actions arising from the negligent, reckless or willful acts of misconduct by Client, or its Agents, in attempting to collect any just and legal debt under this agreement.
- 8. This agreement is valid for twelve (12) months from the dated signature. This agreement shall automatically renew at the end of the twelve (12) months under the same terms
- 9. This agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice; that notice must include a specific cause for termination.
- 10. CCB will not cancel back any account receivable assigned to CCB for which judgment has been obtained or that is in the process of being obtained, or any account receivable on which there is an established plan for repayment. All other cancellation requests are handled on a case by case basis.
