FALL RIVER COUNTY APPROVED MINUTES OF DECEMBER 21, 2023

The Fall River Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on December 21, 2023. Present: Joe Allen, Les Cope, Joe Falkenburg, Heath Greenough, Deb Russell and Sue Ganje, Auditor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given, and the meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; none were noted. ALL MOTIONS RECORDED IN THESE MINUTES WERE PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. Motion made by Russell, seconded by Greenough, to approve the agenda with the addition of discussion and possible action on providing a Holiday/End of the Year bonus.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to approve the minutes of the County Commissioners for December 7, 2023.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Greenough, to approve the Auditor's Account with the Treasurer for November 2023.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to reset the Minimum/No Maintenance Road Hearing from January 4, 2024, to January 18, 2024 at 9:30 a.m.

Motion made by Greenough, seconded by Russell to set a Supplement and Contingency Hearing for December 28, 2023, at 9:30 a.m.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Russell, to approve the pay increase for Jailer Hayley Rough Surface from \$19.75/hr to \$21.00/hr plus 2-year longevity of \$25.00/month, effective 12/14/2023; Maintenance Wesley Wood from \$18.50/hr to \$19.25/hr, effective 12/21/2023; and Heavy Equipment Operator Cory Amthor from \$21.00/hr to \$21.75/hr, effective 12/27/2023; all as per Union Contract.

Sheriff Lyle Norton, met with the Board to request approval for two items and to give the jail count as follows: The jail population for 2023 was 6,663 (which averages to be 18.25 inmates per day) and to provide the following current jail count of 8 inmates, 6 male and 2 females.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to authorize Sheriff Norton to sign the 2024 Prisoner Housing Contract with Pennington County with the daily per inmate amount of \$95.00/day with special management daily amount of \$120.00/day.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Greenough, to approve hiring Cody Blessing as Dispatcheruncertified at \$18.50/hr, effective 12/10/2023.

Frank Maynard, Emergency Manager, met with the Board to discuss the location of the South Radio Repeater installation and go over the coverage maps that included the Eckard Well site and Oelrichs water tower site. He then provided updates that included Fires and Incidents.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Russell, to locate the South Radio Repeater at the Eckard Well site. With Greenough voting no, all others voting yes, motion carried.

Andersen Engineers met with the Board to present a plat for their approval.

Motion made by Greenough, seconded by Allen, to approve the following plat contingent upon the approval of the County Highway Superintendent:

Nina Steinmetz, Weed & Pest Supervisor, met with the Board to request travel approval and to approve appointment of a new Weed Board member.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Russell, to approve travel for Nina Steinmetz and Board member Wayne Hageman to travel to Spearfish for the 2024 State Weed and Pest Conference February 21-23, 2024 at a total cost of \$946.00.

Motion made by Cope, seconded by Greenough, to appoint Jill Oechsle to the Weed Board.

Lily Heidebrink, Director of Equalization, met with the Board requesting hire approval.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Greenough to approve hiring Joseph Goraczkowski as an Administrative Assistant in the Director of Equalization Office at a rate of \$15.00 per hour, effective December 26, 2023.

The Commissioners discussed the proposed Justice Center. Joe Allen was asked to bring the old plan to the December 28th meeting to share with the commissioners.

Discussion was held on offering an "End of the Year" bonus of \$250.00 for employees which included a reimbursement from Oglala Lakota County of 50% for their contracted employees and Fall River paying the balance.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Falkenburg, to approve paying \$250.00 to non-contracted employees and paying \$250.00 to the contracted employees with 50% of that to be reimbursed by Oglala Lakota County. With Russell and Falkenburg voting yes, all others voting no, motion failed.

Joe Falkenburg, Chairman, declared the meeting adjourned at 10:47 a.m.
