FALL RIVER COUNTY UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF JANUARY 18, 2024

The Fall River Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on January 18, 2024. Present: Joe Allen, Les Cope, Joe Falkenburg, Heath Greenough, Deb Russell and Sue Ganje, Auditor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given, and the meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; none were noted. ALL MOTIONS RECORDED IN THESE MINUTES WERE PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to approve the agenda as with the addition of consideration of purchase of a new laptop computer for Commissioner meeting video feed and to move the No Maintenance Road hearing time to 10:00 a.m. as published in the newspaper and move items that were on the agenda later up to fill the 9:30 a.m. time.

Maynard then informed the Board that the 2024 Homeland Security Grant applications are still open for non-profits until February 15th. He also noted that the SDPA Pipeline Training will be held on February 5, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at the Catholic Church in Hot Springs and Commissioners are welcome to attend. He reported on a Black Hills Energy power outage that occurred for 7 hours on January 13th that commissioned a combined effort from Custer County, Fall River County and Black Hills Energy to coordinate assistance to individuals that needed support for life-sustaining equipment. Commissioner Falkenburg inquired about getting a special blanket that can be put on fires that involve electric cars, Maynard will look into it. Gary Baker, Assistant Emergency Manager then reported on the ICS 300 training that he attended in Rapid City. Fires and incidents were reported.

WHEREAS, the Fall River County Board of Commissioners did adopt the following 2024 ANNUAL LOAD RESTRICTIONS:

Fall River County will impose load limits as follows in coordination with the State Highway's Annual Load Restrictions:

All oil roads will be posted at 7 ton and 40 mph, with the exception of County Road 6N aka as Look Out Road to be posted at 10 ton. These are seasonal Spring Load Limits and the restrictions will take effect when the signs are in place.

Motion made by Allen, seconded by Russell, to approve the travel request for Randy Seiler to attend the 2024 Short Course in Deadwood at The Lodge March 19-21, 2024 at a cost of \$100.00 plus lodging.

Joe Allen, Commissioner, presented a proposal from the American Legion to request a small portion of land on the hill by the Fall River County Museum be donated to erect a large pole for an American Garrison flag. After discussion regarding agreement possibilities, all were agreeable to consider an official proposal in the future.

Lance Russell, State's Attorney, met with the Board.

Motion made by Cope, seconded by Russell to authorize the State's Attorney to begin the eviction process on Laura Sedlacek at the physical address of 406 6th Ave, Edgemont, SD/legal description of the N50' of Lots 1, 2 & 3, Block 9, Stewart's Addition to Edgemont, Fall River County, South Dakota, which is owned by Fall River County. With Falkenburg abstaining, all others voting yes, motion carried.

The Board would like discretion to be used as to the time of year and weather conditions for the actual eviction.

Melody Engebretson, Register of Deeds, met with the Board.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to appoint Amber Tschacher as Deputy Register of Deeds, with an increase of \$.35/hr as per Union Contract, effective immediately.

A discussion was held regarding the letter from KD Contractors, Inc. that included a letter from SD DANR to licensed mine operators about the proposed legislation amending SDCL Chapter 45-6, Sand, Gravel, and Construction Aggregate Mining

Motion made by Greenough, seconded by Cope, to approve writing a letter to the SD DANR opposing the proposed legislation amendment.

State's Attorney Russell came back to the Board to request that they approve opposing a rule from the SEC that would affect the BLM lands.

Motion made by Greenough, seconded by Allen, to approve Fall River County Resolution 2024-16 as follows:

FALL RIVER COUNTY COMMISSION RESOLUTION NUMBER 2024-16

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2023, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") published in the Federal Register a public notice entitled: "Self-Regulatory Organizations; New York Stock Exchange LLC; Notice of Filing of Proposed Rule Change to Amend the NYSE Listed Company Manual To Adopt Listing Standards for Natural Asset Companies" (NAC)(Proposed Rule); and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule allows for federal lands, including national parks and other publicly owned lands, to be included in private investment portfolios; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule appears to allow NACs to have management authority over assets held in the portfolio, including our public lands; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule appears to create a new incentive for non-government corporate control over our publicly shared lands; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule will likely facilitate a preservationist-only approach to federal land management instead of an “all-of-the-above” working lands approach as intended by the creation of our federal land laws and programs; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule appears to allow foreign investment in these uniquely U.S. assets, creating national security threats; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule prioritizes conservation over the multiple-use approach on our federal lands in tandem with financial incentives for corporate management; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule is most likely intended to serve as the funding mechanism for the BLM’s recent proposed rule: “Conservation and Landscape Health” that authorizes the granting of “conservation leases” for public land; and

WHEREAS, The BLM rule states that “once the BLM has issued a conservation lease, the BLM shall not authorize any other uses of the leased lands that are inconsistent with the authorized conservation use” thereby prohibiting productive economic uses like grazing, logging or mining; and

WHEREAS, The BLM rule restrictions on productive economic uses are contrary to FLPMA’s multiple use and sustained yield provisions; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule provides a device that entities can facilitate the funding to pay for leases that have little or no economic value; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rule is designed to implement BLM’s violation of its Organic Act, the Federal Land Policy and Management Act (FLPMA); and

WHEREAS, The SEC was created to regulate markets by preventing fraudulent and manipulative practices, just like this ponzi scheme, in order to prevent stock market crashes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FALL RIVER COUNTY COMMISSION, that the proposed rule should not be adopted as it is extremely dangerous and violates federal law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE FALL RIVER COUNTY COMMISSION, that the SEC review the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as an “agency must point to clear congressional authorization for the power it claims.” West Virginia v. EPA, 142 S. Ct. 2587, 2609 (2022).

A discussion took place regarding the configuration/reconstruction of the current jail or proposed Justice Center. Presiding Judge Pfeifle spoke about security issues and staff and public safety. He informed the Board that the Unified Judicial System has put together a committee to address some of these issues and advised that the State of SD has authorized grant funding to help with some of these concerns. He urged the County to watch for and apply for these grants. He feels that the best option would be to move forward with new construction so that we can start fresh with up-to-date safety measures, etc. in mind, instead of trying to retrofit the current aging facilities. Kent Hanson, Chief US Probation/Pretrial Service Officer (retired), met with the Board to offer some insight into the Federal Court System. Federal detainees are no higher risk, no greater danger, and not much different than the detainees that Fall River County Jail has had over the years. Court currently has a lot of congestion, defendants and witnesses have to intermingle with the public due to the configuration of the buildings. John Runner, US Marshall's Service met with the Board to report on the need for more space to house inmates in Western South Dakota and to answer questions from the Commissioners and the public. Contracts between the US Marshall's Service and the counties are in 3-year increments. He said that any inmate requiring medical treatment, etc. would be paid for by the US Marshall, the only requirement is submitting paperwork from a medical provider for the need. There would not be the same costs to the County as with County detainees. The County would provide housing to include feeding; any special provisions are paid for by the US Marshall. They would also prefer to house prisoners at more of closer proximity to where they have court and not have to defer to out-of-state facilities. Rachel Hosterman, Sheriff's Department Office Manager provided a slide show of an overview regarding questions that have been raised. Cory Miller, President of Elevatus Architecture then came in front of the Board to answer questions. He stated that

projects are a work in progress, things change. They work with those changes as things move forward. The Board also heard questions and comments from various audience members.

Break was taken at 12:13 p.m. The meeting resumed at 12:20 p.m.

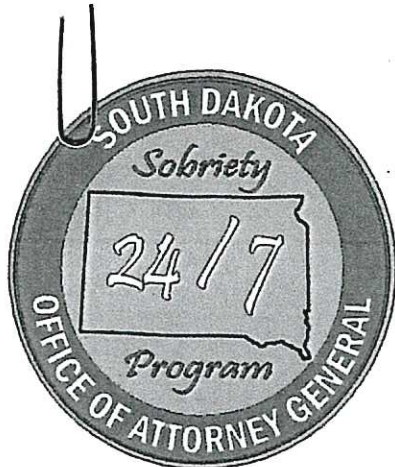

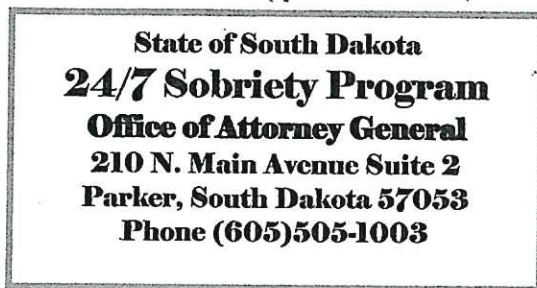

Subj: Commission Update: South Annex Water Issue

1. Saturday, January 13, 2024: City employee noted water leaking out of the area by the curb stop at the South Annex. Shut the curb stop off, and the water leak stopped.
2. Monday-Thursday, January 15-18, 2024: I called and left messages with local contractors about getting someone to repair the leak, no one returned my calls. Nina brought large water containers in, so we could flush toilets and fill the toilet tank, but this was restricted to employees only. Meetings and appointments were cancelled.
3. Friday, January 19, 2024: I contacted the Mayor and City Administrator and asked if they could possibly help resolve the issue of no water. They contacted DRM (highway builders) and I received a call from them, indicating they had people working in Hot Springs, but due to the frigid cold, they could not do any road construction. The DRM person said they would have employees cut the concrete out on Monday, January 22, 2024.
4. Monday, January 22, 2024: DRM saw cut the concrete out.
5. Tuesday, January 23, 2024: DRM had a truck with an earth vacuum, and the ground around the curb stop was cleaned out. When the curb stop was exposed, a small section of pipe connecting the curb stop to the building water line was leaking. DRM and the City Water employees replaced the damaged piece of pipe, installed a new curb stop and the water was turned back on.
6. Wednesday, January 24, 2024: DRM compacted the hole, installed rebar and prepared the area for concrete.
7. Thursday, January 25, 2024: DRM had concrete delivered by Simon and the area was patched. DRM had a bob cat and they removed the ice and snow from the sidewalk while they were at the South Annex.



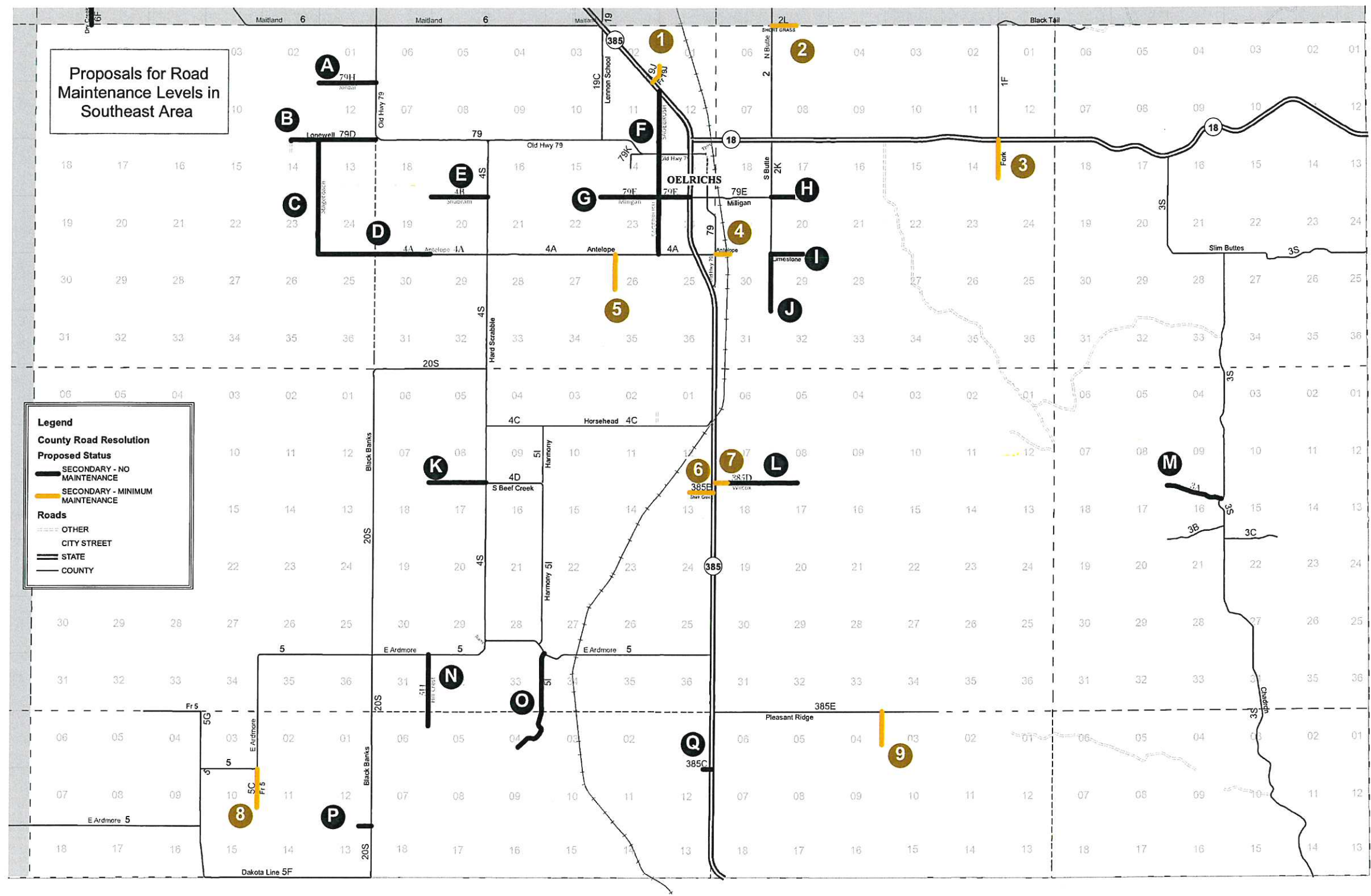
