FALL RIVER COUNTY UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF DECEMBER 5, 2024

The Fall River Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on December 5, 2024. Present: Joe Allen, Les Cope, Joe Falkenburg, Heath Greenough, Deb Russell and Sue Ganje, Auditor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given, and the meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; Cope noted that he had a conflict with the first item on the agenda. ALL MOTIONS RECORDED IN THESE MINUTES WERE PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. The full context of the meeting can be found on the County website under Commissioners at http://fallriver.sdcounties.org, or on Facebook, on the Fall River County's website.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Cope, to approve the agenda as written.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to amend the motion made at the November 21, 2024 meeting to pay entities for omitted mill levies for 2023, pay 2024 tax levies: Oelrichs School, Special Education in the amount of \$132,829.52 that was erroneously published as \$132,892.52 in the agenda and the minutes. With Cope abstaining, all others voting yes, motion carried.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Cope, to approve the Fall River County Commission Meeting minutes from November 21, 2024.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to set the Year-End meeting for Friday, December 27, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.

Discussion was held on the land lease. Motion made by Russell, seconded by Cope, to set a hearing date for sealed bids for December 27, 2024 at 9:45 a.m. for the property that the County leases, for a 3-year period. With all voting no, motion died.

After discussion, it was decided to pursue selling, rather than leasing, the county owned property. The State's Attorney will draft a month-by-month lease agreement with the current lessee until a determination made by the Commission regarding selling the property has been made. This will be brought back to the next meeting.

Vince Logue, Civil Deputy Sheriff, met with the Board to discuss County liens. Currently, there is \$3,634,193.00 outstanding. He presented a method that is an option to recoup the money using legal action through a judgement, which would be through an Execution Process. This would allow for the County to include a 6% commission along with 10% interest on top of the amount owed for the lien. State's Attorney Russell interjected that there would need to be a change in legislation. He said that he would work with Sue Ganje, Auditor, to draft a letter to the Association to take back to legislature to try and get 2013-SB70 reversed or similarly changed to make it easier for counties to collect on the liens.

Lyle Norton, Sheriff, met with the Board. He provided the jail census. There are a total of 17 inmates, 13 males, 3 females, with 1 male in Meade County. He reported that they had received a Homeland Security Grant for radios in the amount of \$18,335.00. Stacey Martin, GIS, had worked to do clean-up and maintenance on the 911system, and the county was awarded \$3,000.00 for 911 Dispatch. Norton then informed the Board of a quote he received for Electrical work that will need to be done to accommodate the new Dispatch location in the amount of \$23,717.00. They are still hoping to be in the new location by the first part of January. Lastly, Norton reported that the newest acquired Sheriff vehicle had been involved in an vehicle accident.

Dar Coy, Emergency Manager, met with the Board to present updates and report on incidents.

Brett Blessing, Highway Foreman, met with the Board.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen to approve the Brosz Engineering work order/proposal for professional services for the 2025 Chip Seal and CM for Hot Brook Rd and Oral Rd Project east in the amount of \$12,185.00 for design and plan preparations, with construction management not to exceed \$15,280.00.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to approve the purchase of a stainless-steel sander in the amount of \$2,000.00 and a poly plow in the amount of \$1,500.00.

Motion made by Cope, seconded by Russell, to approve the Approach Permit from Sherry Gutsche on the south side of Old Hwy 18 at approximately 28588 Old Hwy 18 to serve a residence. With Greenough voting no, all others voting yes, motion carried.

Blessing then provided updates.

Motion made by Russell, seconded by Allen, to approve Fall River County Resolution #2024-87 as follows:

FALL RIVER COUNTY RESOLUTION #2024-89

WHEREAS: The traceability program is incremental. USDA APHIS stated on its website, updated October 11th, 2024 after approving the new rule, that it "is committed to implementing a modern system that tracks animals from birth to slaughter", and

WHEREAS: The cost of EID tags disproportionately burdens small and medium sized independent farmers and ranchers. The USDA rule allows large, corporate-owned herds to be grouped and tagged as one group, creating huge loophole that keep costs low for larger companies, and

WHEREAS: The EID mandate would potentially interfere with price discovery found in traditional markets, thereby furthering vertical integration of the US food supply at the expense of the consumer and independent producer, and

WHEREAS: The EID mandate is far overreaching, intrusive and potentially circumvents privacy laws, threatening the livelihood independent cattle and bison producers, and

WHEREAS: Independent, family-owned cattle ranches are of paramount importance to our local economy and to the economy as a whole, and

WHEREAS: The comments received by USDA APHIS in the rulemaking process were overwhelmingly against the new rule, and

WHEREAS: America has the safest and highest quality meat in the world using our current, fully functioning and effective traceability system. The mandated rule claims to be about animal health, but does nothing to prevent or treat disease, and

WHEREAS: South Dakota Codified Law 40-3-27 provides for identification of animals and premises involved in animal movement. The Animal Industry Board may develop and implement specific programs for the identification of animals and premises involved in animal movements. Any program implemented pursuant to §§ 40-3-27 to 40-3-29, inclusive, must provide for confidentiality of identification records other than those records requested by law enforcement officers of the state and those records used for mandatory disease control or eradication efforts. A livestock owner may choose to identify animals using any methods set forth in 9 C.F.R. part 86, as adopted on January 9, 2013, as well as any additional methods that are later approved by the South Dakota Animal Industry Board pursuant to this section, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Fall River County Commission vehemently opposes the implementation of any EID mandate by the USDA, with the suggestion that funds currently earmarked for this program be reallocated to efforts to restore import standards that protect all livestock producers and consumers from introduction to foreign animal disease.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Fall River County Commission requests that all elected Republican Representatives make every effort to block this government overreach by the Biden/Harris Administration's USDA.

After reviewing our board's tally sheets for Edgemont Precinct, we found our original tally was accurate. However, on closer examination, we totaled the Presidential race ballots on our sheets to be 667 and remembered there were approximately 3 no votes (undervotes) on ballots which would total 670. If we take the 670 ballots that we thought we audited, less the 645 from the tabulator total, the difference is 25. We must have counted a batch of 25 ballots twice. Therefore, we believe that we erroneously added votes to all race totals.

CONTRACT FOR HOUSING OF PRISONERS AND DETAINEES IN THE PENNINGTON COUNTY JAIL

Comes now, the Pennington County Sheriff (PCSO), located at 300 Kansas City Street in Rapid City, South Dakota and the Fall River County Sheriff (FRCSO), located at 906 N. River Street in Hot Springs, South Dakota, and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, PCSO manages and operates the Pennington County Jail located at 307 Saint Joseph Street in Rapid City, South Dakota used for housing of prisoners and detainees and that FRCSO does not have adequate facilities in Fall River County (FRC) for the housing of prisoners and detainees, and

WHEREAS, PCSO is willing to enter an agreement with FRCSO for the housing of prisoners and detainees from FRC under the terms and conditions set forth herein.

ACCORDINGLY, the parties stipulate and agree as follow:

- 1. PCSO agrees to house and take care of prisoners and detainees of FRC, provide food, clothing, bedding, shoes, hygiene supplies, and other items provided to Pennington County (PC) prisoners on a daily basis. Supervision will be provided by PCSO or its designee in accordance with the written document known as the PC Jail Policies and Procedures Manual. In return for said services being performed by PCSO, FRCSO agrees to pay PCSO [\$105] per day for each inmate day. Inmates identified by PCSO as special management due to behavioral, medical, or mental health issues that utilize more resources will be billed at [\$125] per day for each inmate day. PCSO will communicate with FRCSO prior to charging the increased rate. PCSO will bill for the day of arrival but not for the day of departure.
- 2. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that it is their responsibility to transport prisoners to the PC Jail at their expense and to provide transportation for prisoners to and from Court at the expense of FRCSO. FRCSO further agrees and understands that it is the responsibility of FRCSO to know when prisoners of FRC are to be in Court. FRCSO also agrees that PCSO does not routinely provide transportation for inmates to Court, Video Court, or medical facilities. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that if transportation is requested by FRCSO and agreed to by PCSO, PCSO will bill transportation costs to FRCSO at [\$0.70] per mile and [\$35.00] per hour for one deputy/guard and an additional [\$35.00] per hour for any additional deputy/guard, as deemed necessary by PCSO. Transportation costs include moving

- prisoners to video court within the PC Jail. All transport costs have a minimum fee of one hour, with billing occurring in ¼-hour increments after the first hour.
- 3. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that PCSO will, when necessary, provide extraordinary and emergency medical or dental care for prisoners or detainees of FRC, that FRCSO will pay the entire expense associated with said extraordinary and emergency medical or dental care; including transportation to and from medical or dental facilities, hospital expenses, drug expenses, doctor expenses, guard fees and any other necessary and proper expenses born by PCSO in connection with extraordinary and emergency medical and dental care. FRCSO herein further agrees and understands that the determination as to whether or not medical or dental care is an emergency will be left to the discretion of the PCSO or his designee. If extraordinary care is indicated, the PCSO will consult with FRCSO to determine proper and reasonable medical care for which FRCSO will be financially responsible.
- 4. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that PCSO will bill FRCSO for prisoners and detainees held by PCSO for FRCSO. Said bill shall include the cost of each days housing or lodging at the rate of [\$105] per day and any and all medical, mental health, dental or physician care incurred by PCSO. FRCSO agrees to reimburse PCSO on a monthly basis for all bills submitted by PCSO.
- 5. FRCSO herein agrees and understands that all prisoners and detainees of FRC housed in the PC Jail are subject to supervision provided by the PCSO or his designee in accordance with the written documentation known as the PC Jail Policies and Procedures Manual and any and all State standards that may be forth coming by the South Dakota legislature or other authorized committee or agency of the State of South Dakota.
- 6. FRCSO agrees to hold harmless and indemnify PC, PCSO and its officers, agents and employees, from and against any and all claims, actions, suits, damages, liability, judgments or other proceedings, including attorney fees and court costs, which may arise as a result of FRC prisoners and detainees being housed in the PC Jail and receiving medical or dental care and transportation services, all as contemplated and authorized in this Agreement. This section does not require FRCSO to hold harmless and indemnify PC, PCSO and its officers, agents and employees from claims or liability arising solely from the acts or omissions of PCSO, its officers, agents and employees.
- 7. The parties to this agreement herein fully agree and understand that PCSO may cancel this agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the FRCSO. Said notice shall be sent by certified or registered mail. FRCSO herein agrees and understands it shall have no claim or claims of any kind against PC or the PCSO for cancellation of this agreement. FRCSO further agrees and understands that should

PCSO wish to alter any terms or conditions of this agreement, including the cost of housing prisoners, that said alterations or changes shall be provided in writing to the FRCSO by certified mail and FRCSO herein agrees and understands that said alterations or changes shall commence and take full force and effect thirty (30) days after notice of the same is received by FRCSO.

- 8. The parties to this agreement specifically agree and understand that any and all changes in this agreement shall be made in writing and attached to the master copy of this agreement which shall be held by PCSO. The parties to this agreement do further agree and understand that this agreement constitutes the complete understanding and agreement of the parties hereto and that no other oral agreements have been made that are binding upon the parties hereto.
- 9. FRCSO herein agrees to provide copies of the authority to PCSO to hold a prisoner or detainee. The authority to hold shall be either an Order of the Court, Warrant of Arrest and/or Complaint, Bench Warrant, Traffic Citation, Sentence, together with the signature of the officer delivering said prisoner or detainee on a form entitled Custody Authorization Form. PCSO reserves the right to reject any prisoner or detainee delivered without adequate authorization. Said paperwork is the consent of FRCSO for PCSO to bill FRCSO under the terms and conditions of this agreement or future addendum or modification of this contract.
- 10. FRCSO hereby acknowledges that PC is the owner of the PC Jail and that the operation and management of said Jail is vested in PCSO. Any rights, terms or condition provided for in the PC Jail as part of this agreement vests in, and is subject to, the ultimate control of PCSO.
- 11. Effective Date/Term of this Agreement is January 01, 2025 thru December 31, 2025.

Report of inspection

On 11/22/2024—2:42 PM — after observing at the complaint site areas, which were mapped in the prairie dog town located on the Henderson property the following is our findings:

Area X - Henderson side - Five to 6 active holes could be seen in the count areas with prairie dogs moving to and from holes.

Brunson side - 5 Active holes where found.

Area Y - No active holes on either side of the fence.

Area Z - Henderson side - +20 active holes with dogs present.

Brunson side - +10 active holes.

Map of areas is on the back of this letter.

The Fall River County Weed & Pest Board at this time is requesting <u>treatment dates for the past 2 months and any future scheduled treatment dates</u> that will be conducted to achieve a reduction on the Henderson property. <u>This</u> written information needs to be turned into the Board by January 2nd, 2025.

The Fall River County Weed & Pest Board also has requested written proposed method(s) and scheduled treatment dates that will be conducted to achieve a reduction on the neighboring property by the property owners.

On January 2nd, 2025, a second inspections and count will be conducted by the Fall River County Weed & Pest supervisor to continue monitoring the town and neighboring properties. If there is no <u>written</u> communication of scheduled treatment dates, the next step for the Board may be to put a Notice of Declaration of Infestation on the property.

The County is more than willing to assist with control if a request is made.







FALL RIVER COUNTY GIS USER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the User has requested that Fall River County supply the User with digital data;

WHEREAS, Fall River County is agreeable to copying the digital data at an agreed cost to the User, provided that the User complies with the terms of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the User and Fall River County agree as follows:

- 2. Fall River County agrees to copy and deliver to the User digital data as requested.
- 3. The digital data to be provided is specifically described as follows:

 Ownership information, with mail addresses and names, and the parcel boundaries with their unique identifiers, ideally in a shapefile format.
- 4. User shall pay to Fall River County the sum of \$50 prior to any digital data being provided to User.
- 5. Fall River County hereby disclaims any and all liability or responsibility for damage, injury, loss, claim or lawsuit arising from any error, inaccuracy or other problem with either the digital data provided to the User in any medium or format. The User herby releases Fall River County, its officers, agents and all employees and volunteers from all liability, damages, claims, injuries or suits arising from such error, inaccuracy or problem.

 Furthermore, the User agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Fall River County and its officers, agents and all employees and volunteers, from any and all claims, liability, damages, injuries and suits arising from use of the digital data, provided to the User in any medium or format, by the User, its employees or assignees, or by any third parties.

notice to the offending party, stating the grounds, facts and circumstances that it believes led to the breach of this Agreement.

The party receiving such notice of breach shall have thirty (30) days form the date that notice was delivered to them, as indicated on the return receipt, to correct said breach. If said breach is not corrected, then the non-offending party may terminate this Agreement and may seek the appropriate relief as provided by South Dakota Codified Law.

- 16. The parties agree that even if a party does not enforce the other parties' breach of a provision of this Agreement, the failure to do so shall not be deemed a waiver of that parties' right to enforce any subsequent breach or default of the same or similar nature. Any waiver by a party of a right provided for in this Agreement must be in writing and signed by the parties to be effective.
- 17. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the substantive laws of the State of South Dakota.
- 18. Any dispute arising between the parties shall be brought before the Seventh Judicial Circuit Court, State of South Dakota, and the parties hereto consent to the jurisdiction of said court.
- 19. This Agreement may be modified only if said modification is in writing and signed by all the parties.
- 20. User agrees and hereby represents that in this Agreement, it was and is acting solely on its own, and acting through its own knowledge, and it is not in any manner relying upon any representation either from the Fall River County, its officials or any employee. This Agreement incorporates all the demands that User has made in regard to determining and fully settling all the terms and conditions herein. User hereby states and represents and warrants that it executes this Agreement of its own free will and based upon its own independent judgement.
- 21. The foregoing Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and there is no other oral or collateral Agreement between the parties.

SECRETARY OF STATE RELEASES RESULTS OF COUNTY POST-ELECTION AUDITS

(Pierre, S.D.) – Secretary of State Monae L. Johnson announces that county auditors have completed their post-election audits for the 2024 General Election. The audits revealed only minor discrepancies (typically 1-2 votes), which were primarily due to manual counting methods, where audit boards focused on determining voter intent rather than strictly adhering to oval marks on the ballot. The vast majority of counties reported no discrepancies between the hand-counted audits and the machine-tabulated results from election night.

"The accuracy and transparency demonstrated by this process highlight the strength of our election system," said Secretary of State Johnson. "Every South Dakotan can be confident that their vote was counted correctly and securely. Our county auditors and their teams continue to uphold the highest standards, ensuring trust and integrity in our elections. Their commitment to fairness and transparency makes me proud to serve alongside them."
